To complete the level 2 qualification students are required to support a minimum of 3 consecutive sessions within a Forest School programme being run by a level 3 Leader. It is usual that students will arrange this themselves, however if participants do not yet have contact with a Forest School, our tutors may be able to signpost students to existing Forest Schools if needed.
